March 20, 2020

This COVID-19 pandemic is changing rapidly, and it is important for everyone to remember not to spread rumors or panic.

Stelco announced on March 19, 2020 as an additional screening measure they will be doing non-invasive, handheld temperature sensors at all gates.

It may take days or even weeks before this equipment is available. We will inform the members on this process as it unfolds.

Try to keep a physical distance of 6 feet between each other. If you develop a fever, respiratory symptoms, coughing and or shortness of breath. Isolate and quarantine.

Hamilton has set up COVID-19 Assessment Centre's.
