



LOCAL 1005 EDUCATION COMMITTEE NOTICE POST-SECONDARY SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS – 2022

The Education Fund of Local 1005, U.S.W. is offering (1) award of \$1005.00 for the John Lennie Scholarship and (1) \$1005.00 award for the Jake Isbister Scholarship and (1) \$1005.00 for the Jimmy Lomax and (1) \$1005.00 for the Joe Choscinski Scholarship to students, in Ontario.

The conditions of these scholarships are a) previous winners are not eligible b) the scholarships shall be awarded only to sons and daughters of members of Local 1005 United Steelworkers c) applicants can apply for all four but are only eligible to win one award.

Recipients of scholarships must be prepared to show their level of education is sufficient to allow admittance to an approved institution of higher education, such as a university, technological institute, teacher's college, nursing school, etc.

The student must complete an application form which must be mailed to Education Chairperson, Local 1005, U.S.W., 350 Kenilworth Ave. N., Hamilton, Ontario L8H 4T3.

The application form must be submitted no later than **June 30, 2022**, and must be accompanied by an essay dealing with one of the following topics.

JAKE ISBISTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1) POLITICAL ACTION

• Explain how political action is essential to achieving a better life for workers and their families.

JIMMY LOMAX MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

2) COLLECTIVE BARGAINING

 What can Unions do to when Government legislates workers back to work instead of negotiating and respecting the collective bargaining process.

JOHN LENNIE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

3) DEFENDING WORKERS RIGHTS DURING A PANDEMIC

 Describe how this new reality of work during the Covid-19 pandemic has impacted Canadian Unions and their members' rights.

JOE CHOSCINSKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

4) USW IS KNOWN AS THE HEALTH & SAFETY UNION

• Explain what USW has achieved throughout its history to be recognized as the health and safety union.

ALL ESSAYS MUST STATE PROPER CITATION AND REFERENCE LISTS.
ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE FOLLOWING.
(NO EXCEPTIONS)

- 1. Proof of acceptance at an institution of higher education.
- 2. Your academic records (Transcripts).
- 3. A letter of reference from your Principal if you are in your last year of High School and entering an accredited university or college.
- 4. The 1,000 word essay (John Lennie Scholarship) or 1,000 word essay (Jake Isbister Scholarship) or 1,000 word essay (Jimmy Lomax Scholarship), or 1,000 word essay (Joe Choscinski Scholarship)

NOTE: LOCAL 1005 IS NOT INVOLVED IN THE SELECTION AND GRADING PROCESS.
